

## **SUMMARY OF THE MCPC STATED SESSION MEETING OF JANUARY 10, 2021.**

- Session received the Treasurer's 2020 year-end report and approved the 2021 budget for MCPC.
- The Clerk's Report included recording the January 5, 2021 death of MCPC member Carolyn Muir.
- The Pastor's Report was received. Highlights included Diane's continuing participation with the PNNE clergy women, noting her upcoming Transforming Community Retreat, reporting that the women's Reformation study was going well, and expressing gratitude for the blessing of a week off before Christmas. Pastor Diane requested that the church office be open Wednesdays from noon until 2:00 PM; session supported that proposal. Pastor Diane also shared plans for Ash Wednesday's imposition of ashes and worship service.
- The bright start board of directors will meet in March 2021.
- The Property Committee Report of 12-19-2020 was received. Highlights were issues with pressure valves on the boiler preventing proper operation and a leaky drain valve in the Fellowship Hall ceiling, both issues have been successfully addressed. Property committee reminded Session that thermostats in all spaces should be set to 62 to 63 degrees maximum.
- Jessica Wilcox requested the use of space in the building for working on her veterinarian studies, as all her classes were online and she needed a quiet place to work.
- Special Offerings reported that \$680.00 was received for the 2020 Joy Offering.
