

## SESSION MEETING SUMMARY ~ April 2021

- The Annual Report Reviewing the Year 2020 has been posted on the Mid-Coast Presbyterian Church website with financials and names redacted.
- A new refurbished Toshiba copier for the Church Office has been purchased for the sum of \$1500 and has been installed in the church office.
- Session approved the following three revised documents for the Columbarium Committee's work:
  1. Application for Niches in the Church Columbarium
  2. Church Records for Niche(s) and Inurnment
  3. Certificate of Approved Reservation for Columbarium
- Received the report of the Board of Deacons. Following the Easter service Deacons picked up flowering plants from Pastor Diane's home and delivered them to members and friends of the congregation.
- Received the report of the Worship and Music Team and affirmed the proposed list of Preachers and Worship Leaders for the coming year. The Reverend Bob Beringer will be preaching on April 25 and June 13, both Sundays on which Pastor Diane will be away.
- Received the report of the Property Committee. Spring clean-up is being scheduled. Shingles that have fallen off the roof and need to be replaced and the parking lot lights that are out also need to be replaced with LEDs. Sealing of the parking lot pavement is also to be planned.
- Received the report of the Personnel Committee.
- Received a report from the Bright Start Board. Tentative plans for reopening for the new school year, pending approval by Session and the hiring of a new director are being considered.
- It was with great joy that the Session welcomed Jane Parry into membership of Mid-Coast Presbyterian Church. A public reception will be held at a time to be determined.
- Adopted the following motion regarding the recording of Zoom meetings:
